

## 2017 NOTICE OF ELECTION

In accordance with the Bylaws of the College of Letters and Science, notice is hereby given of the annual College election of officers. Elections follow the procedures for electronic ballots set forth in Senate Bylaw 340 and Divisional Bylaw 150 (G).

### **Election schedule:**

Nominations: All nominations are due by **Thursday, April 20 at noon**. Each nominating petition requires the signature of two Academic Senate members of the College. Members may nominate no more than one candidate for each of the positions to be filled. **Each proposed nominee must certify his/her acceptance by signing the nomination petition**. Completed nominating petitions must be delivered to the Chair of the Faculty, UCLA College, A265 Murphy Hall or emailed to [fecchair@college.ucla.edu](mailto:fecchair@college.ucla.edu)

Electronic Ballots: A ballot notification will be emailed on **Thursday, May 4, 2017**. Voting will take place between **Thursday, May 18** and **Wednesday, May 31**. Election results are announced on **Friday, June 2**.

### **Accepting nominations for the following positions:**

1. Chair of the Faculty: The Chair will serve a two-year term, beginning September 1, 2017. All Academic Senate members in the College are eligible to run and may make nominations.
2. Executive Committee Representative: Each of the groups listed below will elect one representative to the Faculty Executive Committee. Nominees must be members of an eligible group and be nominated by members of the same group. This year's eligible groups include:

Group I            English; Comparative Literature; Gender Studies

Group III        French and Francophone Studies; Germanic Languages; Italian; Near Eastern Languages and Cultures; Slavic, East European, and Eurasian Languages and Cultures; Spanish & Portuguese

Group V	Ecology and Evolutionary Biology; Microbiology, Immunology & Molecular Genetics; Molecular, Cell and Developmental Biology
Group VII	Chemistry & Biochemistry; Earth, Planetary & Space Sciences; Institute of the Environment and Sustainability
Group IX	Asian American Studies; Chicana and Chicano Studies; History; Communication Studies
Group XI	Anthropology; Geography; Sociology
